

Everybody was so nice to me and we were talking a lot with eachother. All in all the exchange was really worth it.



Because they were so kind and always try to help me if I needed it.


2. How much did you learn about the life and culture of Poland during your stay here?




What aspects of life did you learn about?




3. How would you evaluate the cognitive aspect of the visit?








4. Have you become more confident and open-minded thanks to this visit?

Because it was fantastic and amazing!


Because I saw how bad people were treating the people who were in Auschwitz
